Market overview

The S&P/ASX 200 Accumulation Index closed up 2.9% for the month. The best performing sector was the banks (up 4.2%) as investor concerns about the potential impacts of new capital adequacy requirements were assuaged. Other strong performing sectors were energy (up 3.7%) and resources (up 3.4%). In contrast, the healthcare and telco sectors weighed on the Index, falling 1.5% and 0.3% respectively.

Donald Trump's US presidential election victory was the most significant market event in November with investors globally caught off-guard by the poll result. After initially plummeting, equity markets staged strong recoveries as investors focused on the potentially stimulatory impact of Trump's proposed policies. The Australian share market recorded solid gains to end the month 7.1% higher than the intraday lows on 9 November when Trump was elected. On Melbourne Cup day the RBA left interest rates unchanged with rates likely to be on hold for the majority of 2017.

Portfolio update

During the month, the composition of the investment portfolio changed considerably to reflect a number of factors impacting the Australian share market. The investment portfolio's exposure to mid-cap companies was reduced while exposure to larger companies was increased as opportunities presented themselves. We increased our positions in the major banks on account of rising yields, cost reductions and the potentially less restrictive regulatory requirements. Similarly, we increased the investment portfolio's weighting of insurance companies due to a rising yield environment with positions in both QBE Insurance (ASX: QBE) and Suncorp Group (ASX: SUN) higher than earlier in the month. The cash weighting was reduced from 36% to 20% as the share market presented more opportunities during the month.
