Company overview

WAM Capital Limited (WAM) is a listed investment company that provides investors exposure to an actively managed diversified portfolio that concentrates on identifying undervalued growth companies. These are generally found in the small to medium industrial sector. WAM also provides exposure to relative value arbitrage and market mispricing opportunities.

Investment objective

The investment objectives are to deliver a rising stream of fully franked dividends, to provide capital growth and to preserve capital.

Outperformance against sharemarket

Since inception, the WAM investment portfolio has outperformed the overall sharemarket. WAM's performance against the S&P/ASX All Ordinaries Accumulation Index is shown in the table below. The investment performance is before expenses, fees and taxes.

Dividends – 6.0 cents per share fully franked interim

On 25 February 2013, the Company announced a fully franked interim dividend of 6.0 cents per share. This is a 9.1% increase on the previous year's interim dividend and represents an annualised fully franked dividend yield of 7.0% based on the last sale price.

The Board is committed to paying an increasing stream of fully franked dividends to shareholders, provided the Company has sufficient franking credits and it is within prudent business practices. It must also comply with Government legislation and the ATO's interpretation of a company's ability to pay franked dividends. Dividends are paid on a six-monthly basis. Dividend payments will also be made with consideration to cash flow and cash holdings.


WAM Capital options

Option holders are required to exercise their options by 16th April 2013 to be eligible for the 6.0 cent fully franked interim dividend.

Dividend re-investment plan (DRP)

The dividend re-investment plan (DRP) will operate for the interim dividend at a 2.5% discount. To participate in the DRP, please send your election form to our share registrar no later than 23 April 2013. Further details are included in the DRP rules available on our website.

Option issue

On 2 April 2012, the Board announced a 1 for 1 bonus issue of options to acquire ordinary shares in the capital of the Company. Further options were issued as part of the placement in August 2012 and the merger with Premium Investors.

The options have an exercise price of \$1.60 per share and can be exercised at any time on or before 31 July 2013. The options give shareholders the right but not the obligation to subscribe for shares in WAM at \$1.60 per share. The options can be exercised in full or in part. The options are currently trading on the ASX under the code WAMO.

As at 31 March 2013, 51,441,581 options have been exercised and allotted for a total consideration of \$82,306,530. The remaining balance of outstanding options is 110,470,297.

Market outlook

The S&P/ASX All Ordinaries Accumulation Index finished down 2.2% in March. This was the end of a 9 month rally that had seen the market rise every month since last May. A revival of concerns around the European sovereign debt crisis from the Cyprus bailout destabilised financial markets. We also had news from China which suggested the central bank and ministry of housing will seek to dampen Chinese house price growth. This news particularly affected the resources and mining services sector.

The RBA left rates on hold in both March and April and we believe that they will not cut rates any further this year. Improving house prices, retail sales and consumer confidence suggest that the rate cuts delivered over the last 18 months are finally starting to have an impact. The RBA will probably adopt a wait and see approach over this year in order to judge the effectiveness of previous rate cuts. Should this turnaround in consumer sentiment, retail sales and housing continue to strengthen, companies exposed to these sectors will be well positioned.


