

WAM CAPITAL LTD (WAM) ABN 34 086 587 395 INVESTMENT UPDATE & NET TANGIBLE ASSETS REPORT MAY 2013

Company overview

WAM Capital Limited (WAM or the 'Company') is a listed investment company that provides investors exposure to an actively managed diversified portfolio that concentrates on identifying undervalued growth companies. These are generally found in the small to medium industrial sector. WAM also provides exposure to relative value arbitrage and market mispricing opportunities.

Investment objectives

The investment objectives are: to deliver a rising stream of fully franked dividends; to provide capital growth; and to preserve capital.

Performance

Since inception, WAM's investment portfolio has outperformed the overall sharemarket. WAM's performance against the S&P/ASX All Ordinaries Accumulation Index is shown in the table below. The investment performance is before expenses, fees and taxes.



Dividends – 6.0 cents per share fully franked interim

On 30 April 2013, the Company paid a fully franked interim dividend of 6.0 cents per share. This was a 9.1% increase on the previous year's interim dividend and represents an annualised fully franked dividend yield of 7.5% based on the last sale price.

The Board is committed to paying an increasing stream of fully franked dividends to shareholders, provided the Company has sufficient franking credits and it is within prudent business practices. It must also comply with Government legislation and the ATO's interpretation of a company's ability to pay franked dividends. Dividends are paid on a six-monthly basis. Dividend payments will also be made with consideration to cash flow and profitability.

Option issue – exercise at any time before 31 July 2013

On 2 April 2012, the Board announced a one-for-one bonus issue of options to acquire ordinary shares in the capital of the Company. Further options were issued as part of the placement in August 2012 and the merger with Premium Investors.

The options have an exercise price of \$1.60 per share and can be exercised at any time on or before 31 July 2013. The options give shareholders the right, but not the obligation, to subscribe for shares in WAM at \$1.60 per share. The options can be exercised in full or in part. The options are currently trading on the ASX under the code WAMO.

As at 31 May 2013, 125,452,885 options had been exercised and allotted for a total consideration of \$200,724,616. The remaining balance of outstanding options is 36,458,993.

Market outlook

The ASX/S&P All Ordinaries Accumulation Index suffered a sharp decline in May, falling 4.4%, weighed down by a plethora of earnings downgrades across a number of sectors. The RBA cut official interest rates to 2.75%, their lowest in more than 50 years, citing below-trend growth in Australia and overseas. The US Federal Reserve's comments suggesting a tapering of asset purchases in the near term created downward pressure on the market.

Market outlook (continued)

The Australian share market has rallied strongly since June last year. Given that historically share prices generally rise 9 to 12 months before earnings start to improve, the rally reflects the market's expectation that earnings will rise in the short term. Through the month of May, this has not yet eventuated. In light of the recent slew of earnings downgrades, we have become more cautious in our outlook for the Australian share market and have adjusted the portfolio accordingly.


